## Credit Redemption Contract for First Semester LOTE Classes

Students who fail the first semester of a foreign language class with an average of 60-69 may choose to remain in the class during second semester and work toward redeeming credit for first semester by meeting or exceeding the terms of this contract.

- A Level One student must earn a second semester average of at least 75.
- A Level Two, Three, Four or Five student has two options:
  - 1. Earn a second semester average of at least 75, or
  - 2. Earn a second semester average high enough that the two semester grades averaged together equal at least 70.

If a student meets these terms, the transcript will show both the original failing grade and a "redeemed" grade of 70 for first semester. The actual grade earned for second semester will also be entered. Credit for both semesters will be granted. If a student fails to meet these terms, he/she will be required to re-take first semester in order to earn credit.
